4. When is it really dry out, how will a fire be controlled?
5. Who pays for damage if a tornado puts a blade through a house?
6. How much will liability damage cost? A local insurance company says they are NOT covered under the farm policy.
7. What percentage of the total project cost is sent out of the United States?
8. Will landowners still get paid after a new president uses executive order to stop all wind energy subsidies?
9. Will there be any further payments if nuclear energy replaces the wind projects?
10. Why were 3 wind projects decommissioned in less than 15 years in Nebraska?
11. If repairs need to be made while I am harvesting, will I ever be asked to stop or get out of the way? Who does the contract say has priority?
12. Will the contract let me build a shed, or put in a stock well windmill without your permission? Proof?
13. Does the contract make you remove all the concrete when the turbine life comes to an end or it needs to be decommissioned? Proof?
